Dear Ministry Leader,

Greetings from the Urban Mission Field of New York City! Founded in 1984, The New York school of Urban Ministry (NYSUM) is a concept inspired by the Holy Spirit over 40 years ago to confront a number

of challenges faced by the urban church since the '70s.

At the root, we are a training center that teaches practical and effective evangelistic tools through a "hands-on" approach. We host, train and deploy approximately 5,000 youth, adults, and teams each year by partnering with over 100 inner city pastors and churches throughout NYC and provide foundational urban classroom training.

In addition to providing practical urban classroom training, NYSUM provides accommodations and home-style meals for small and large groups at our 74,000 sq. ft. training campus. NYSUM's staff trains students from colleges, seminaries, Bible schools, youth groups, and church groups in "hands-on" cross cultural urban ministry.



Why shortterm missions in New York City?

- Massive Population: New York City has a population of approximately 10 million people, more than the populations of 39 U.S. States. It is roughly equivalent to the combined populations of Los Angeles, Chicago, and Houston.
- Ethnic diversity: NYC is considered the "Most International City in the World." Approximately 36% of New Yorkers are foreign born, and at least 200 languages are spoken here.
- Spiritual Dilemma: New Yorkers face unique opposition as a result of the exposure to hundreds of religions and the steady decline of the faithful Christian Church in the inner-city.
- Homelessness & Poverty: 14% of the U.S. homeless population resides in New York City. While the U.S. average is 13% living below the poverty line, 27.1% of the Bronx's population and 21.9% of Brooklyn's population live below the poverty line.
- Disaster Relief: As a result of the physical, social, and economic devastations caused by Covid-19, the amount of struggling and impoverished New Yorkers has skyrocketed and the need for more "Compassion Commandoes" to go out into the Front Lines of NYC has desperately increased.

Extreme Makeover Weekend

May 17-19, 2024 (Dates subject to change

May 16-18, 2025

(Dates subject to change) 2 Nights. \$214 per person.

During **Extreme Makeover Weekend,** more than 150 women from across North America join with NYSUM to provide more than 500 cosmetic and wardrobe makeover for homeless and battered women residing in New York City shelters. Before the outreach, our staff provides practical training on basic cosmetology and one-on-one evangelism training.

We minister to **over 400 women**, demonstrating how truly loved and valued they are by God. The makeover includes manicures, pedicures, brand new clothing, shoes, accessories, and a very special luncheon.

- Not bringing van: pay NYSUM van transportation (\$214)

City Fest Basketball Outreach

June 20-23, 2024 June 19-24, 2025 4 Nights. \$355 per person.

Each year, we partner with inner-city churches and organizations to reach inner-city youth by hosting a basketball tournament in underprivileged multiethnic neighborhoods in the city, where our volunteers share the Gospel through sports. Medals and trophies are awarded through three-on-three and slam dunk competition.

This outreach also features:

- Children's ministry and face painting stations
- Mobile food truck ministry / homeless outreach
- Street evangelism

Additional cost for in-city transportation:

- Bringing van: pay Metro and tolls
- Not bringing van: pay NYSUM van transportation (\$355)

Back-to-School Backpack Outreach



August 2024: 2-4 • 9-11 • 16-17 • 23-25 August 2025: 1-3 • 8-10 • 15-17 • 22-242 nights. \$214 per person.

We partner with inner-city churches across New York City to bless children in lower income families with **1,000 new backpacks** and school supplies, setting up the youth for academic success and freeing their parents from the worries of back-to-school preparation costs.

This outreach also features: • Face painting, balloon making, games • Clowns, puppets, music • Mobile food truck ministry • Evangelism

Additional cost for in-city transportation:

- Bringing van: pay Metro and tolls
- Not bringing van: pay NYSUM van transportation (\$214)

Operation Drumstick

November 8-10, 2024 November 7-9, 2025 2 nights. \$214 per person.

During **Operation Drumstick,** your team will share the love of Jesus by feeding Thanksgiving meals to struggling families throughout New York City. These hurting people will receive a good old-fashioned Thanksgiving Dinner with all the trimmings: roasted turkey, corn bread stuffing, vegetables, cranberry sauce, and dessert.

This outreach also features: 2 nights of ministering to the homeless while serving on our mobile food truck on the streets of New York.

Additional cost for in-city transportation:

- Not bringing van: pay NYSUM van transportation (\$214)





Christmas Compassion

December 6-11, 2024 December 5-10, 2025 5 nights. \$389 per person.

Every Christmas we distribute over **3,000 toys** to children living in city shelters, and life-essential resources to the homeless, as we demonstrate Christ's love and compassion through this holiday giveaway.

This special outreach features:

- 3 nights of homeless ministry, blessing the homeless with blankets, toiletry packets/hygiene kits, food and water through our mobile food truck, and Gospel literature.
- Singing at Rockefeller Center
- · Children's ministry and city-wide toy giveaway

Additional cost for in-city transportation:

- Bringing van: pay Metro and tolls
- Not bringing van: pay NYSUM van transportation (\$389)

Additional info for all Mission Trip Packages:

Linens

For all our packages, we provide one set of linens (per person) for your whole stay, which includes a washcloth, bath towel, a fitted sheet, flat sheet, pillow case and pillow, and a blanket.

Meals

All three meals daily are included in all our packages and begin with dinner on arrival day and end with breakfast on departing day. Only breakfast is served on Sundays and days off for leisure (during weeklong packages). We unfortunately cannot cater to specific diets or allergies.

In-city Outreach Transportation

Teams than arrive in their own van(s) are required to:

- Use their own van for outreach transportation
- Cover toll fees, gas expenses, and subway fare (when/if needed).

For teams who will require NYSUM van transportation for outreach:

Weeklong packages

Van Use: \$50 per person (1 time charge) Subway: \$34 per person (1 time charge, mandatory) includes 7-Day Unlimited Metro Card*

Weekend / 3 Day packages

\$30 per person – 1 time charge Subway Fare included

*Metro Card subject to change based on New York City MTA.

SUPPORTING MISSIONARY ACCOMMODATIONS

\$47 per person, per night; 1 set of bed linens per stay included. 1 set of bed linens includes: washcloth, towel, fitted sheet, flat sheet, pillow case, pillow and blanket.

SINGLE OUTREACH MINISTRY EXPERIENCE

\$15 per person, per outreach. *Urban training and in-city transportation*. *Meals are an additional cost if needed*.

NYSUM's Heritage

40 Years of Ministry

In 1973, Paul Johansson became aware of a divine assignment to "start a school to train students in cultural and urban challenges and by faith in 1984 he and his wife Gloria moved from the suburbs of Elim, Pennsylvania to New York City to pursue this calling.

Simultaneously, while pastoring in New York, Rev. Robert and Jan Johansson saw the desperate need for more laborers to work alongside city churches and pastors as they recognized the growing urban crisis.

The two brothers then came together, bringing two streams into one river, and gave impetus for the vision to become a reality. It was now time to begin organizing the New York School of Urban Ministry (NYSUM) concept, with the underlying principal being to support and help strengthen local churches and pastors in the city. With that in mind, NYSUM soon began offering practical urban courses to city pastors and leaders.

Today, NYSUM continues to emphasize the importance of character development and practical methodology for ministering daily in the urban environment by training and deploying leaders to support inner-city churches and evangelize on impactful short-term mission trips.
