NYSUM IMPACT

SEPT-DEC. 2023

Your prayers and generosity have helped us impact NYC over the last 4 months.

279 short-term missionaries were trained and deployed to help inner city pastors and churches reclaim their communities for Christ.

Backpacks: We blessed over **1,000** inner-city children with brand new backpacks for back-to-school, partnering with **6** churches throughout NYC.

Operation Drumstick: We fed over **2,500** hurting people during Thanksgiving outreach.

Mobile Food Truck: 32 times, we deployed our mobile food truck to feed and reach families in need. We served 4,633 hot dogs, 383 Cheese Quesadillas, 72 gallons of iced tea and coffee.

Fall / Winter Partnerships: Over **43** churches partner with us to help reclaim their communities.

Christmas Compassion: Over **2,000** Children were blessed with brand new toys, partnering with **12** churches in all five boroughs in NYC.
